



Mogotlho Safari Lodge Fact Sheet

GENERAL INFORMATION

Mogotlho Safari Lodge, named after the majestic Camel thorn trees of the area, is nestled between a Leadwood forest, overlooking the Khwai River, which joins the Moremi Game Reserve. The exceptional location of Khwai makes it a regular host to elephant, buffalo, lion, leopard, cheetah and wild dogs. This is the perfect location for observing the perennial drama of the African bushveld. This place provides easy access to the famous Moremi Game Reserve and Savute/Chobe Game Reserve for exciting day trips and is the perfect stopover between Maun and Kasane.



ACCOMMODATION

Mogotlho comfortably sleeps 26 guests. This eco-green lodge boasts 13 river facing safari tented rooms, complemented by en suite bricked bathrooms. The rooms are spacious and open-plan. Guests can choose between twin single beds or double beds. The more adventurous at heart can opt for the mobile overnight camps in the Okovango Delta, African wilderness at its best.

FACILITIES

The lodge boasts a comfortable lounge area, accompanied by a wildlife library, adjacent to a large wooden deck. A cash bar on the side of the deck overlooks the magnificent Khwai River, Okavango Delta and Botswana.



DINING OPTIONS

A majestic thatch roofed dining area leads out onto an elevated viewing deck over the riverbank. Set menus are served daily and tea and coffee are available in the camp throughout the day.

HOW TO GET THERE

GPS coordinates/Directions

(S19° 13.146' E23° 57.616')

Drive to the South-East, starting at the Wimpy in Maun, (S19° 58.608' E23° 25.858'). Turn left onto the B334, approximately 9.09 km from the Wimpy. Proceed through Shrobe, onto the dirt road, until you cross the Buffalo Vet Fence. About 1125m further, turn right at the dirt road fork. Proceed on this dirt road and pass Sankuyo Village. Keep straight for about 27km and then turn left at the sign, Mogotlho Safari Lodge (S19° 13.146' E23° 57.616').
